The 2022 National Assembly General Elections were guided by the Constitution of Lesotho and the National Assembly Electoral Act of 2011. Upon assuming office in November 2020, the Commission committed to strengthening its capacity to deliver successful elections, engaging relevant stakeholders throughout the process. We remain committed to our post-election roadmap and core values.

Election Technology

This election marks a milestone in technological advancement. We introduced and deployed EVVs nationwide, enabling eligible voters to register using their Identity Documents - a first in our history. This helped combat issues like multiple registrations and outdated rolls. Voters could also update their information online, access the voters' roll on our website, and follow real-time result transmission from districts to the results centre. Despite technical challenges, we successfully implemented this innovation as part of our strategic vision.

We express deep gratitude to national and international election observers. Special thanks to the United Nations, African Union, SADC, European Union, Commonwealth Secretariat, and the SADC Electoral Commissions Forum (ECF-SADC). We also appreciate local observers, political parties, civil society, state agencies, and the media. Your contributions ensured transparency and success of the elections.

Despite facing challenges - including court cases, nomination delays, and ballot printing issues - the Commission remained focused on delivering credible elections. Lessons from this cycle will strengthen our
